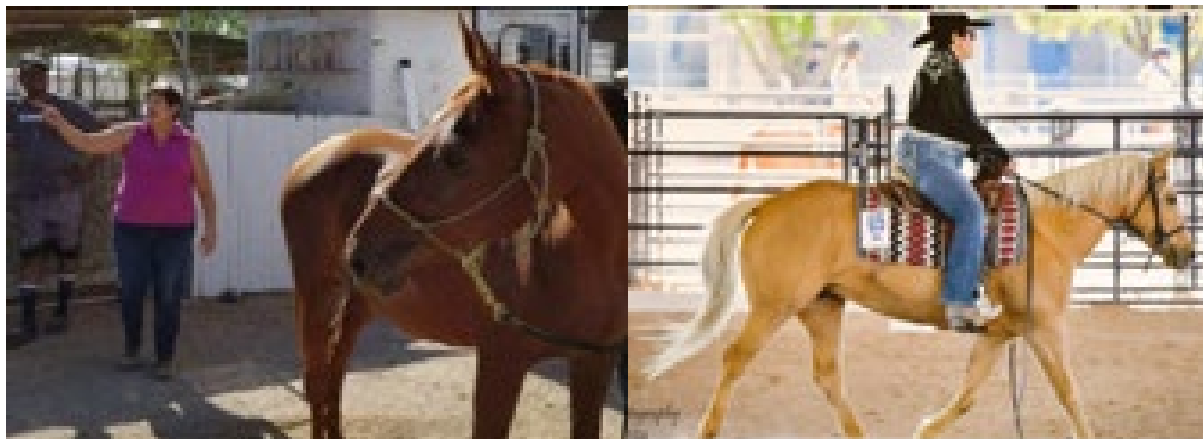

USEF Membership-Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

USEF Lite Competition USEF membership requirements:

A Competing Membership is only required for athletes seeking HOTY points or those signing the entry blank as the trainer/coach (see below).

- Owners of horses seeking HOTY points must be competing members and the horse must have a recording.

Trainer or coach must be a Competing Member and sign the entry blank.

- Youth competing without a trainer or coach will have a parent sign as trainer or coach and the parent must be a Competing Member.
- Those competing without a trainer or coach will be required to sign the entry blank as the trainer/coach, therefore must have a Competing Membership. (GR404.4)

Show Passes are not required.

Headgear Rules follow WDAA rule- D123 Attire 1. Required apparel: a. Suitable western hat. Protective headgear may be worn without penalty. (See **GR801**). Hats and headgear are not required in Costume Freestyle Classes.

Sharps: There will be one sharps container per 50 stalls that are filled with horses at this compitions which is in-line with USEF sharps regulations listed (**GR1210.4**).

Stabling: permanent building structure with stall doors, size: 12'X 12'.

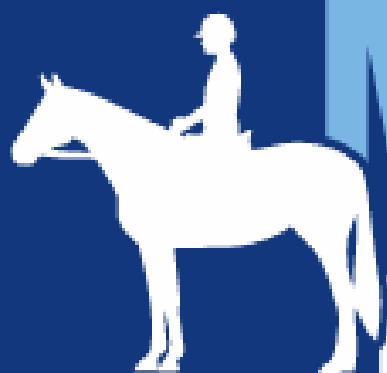

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of H4H/SSWD #307206 (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, Internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my status as a Fan. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. USEF may in its sole discretion, at any time, terminate my USEF Fan status.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and

("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF INHERENT RISKS: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with equine activities, including but not limited to horseback riding and equestrian sport, are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

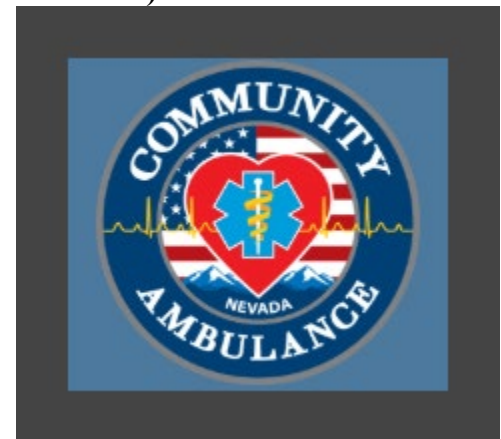

Open status: All trainers are considered open status

Amateur status: If you are entering amateur classes, you will need to provide proof of amateur status with your entry. If you do not have proof of your amateur status, you will be placed in the Open division. You can obtain a USEF-Amateur card at [USEF Membership](#) for more information on obtaining an amateur card. [GR 1306 and GR 1307](#).

Junior status: Riders are eligible to compete as juniors if they are 17 years of age or less at the beginning of the 2026 competition year (December 1, 2025-November 30, 2026). [GR103](#).

Numbers: Each horse will be assigned a unique number. Numbers must be placed on each side of your saddle blanket while showing. We recommend a number holder or laminating your numbers for the season.

Class Restrictions

1. Horses may be ridden by two riders. Each horse/rider combination requires a separate entry with all signatures and emergency contact.
2. No horse may be ridden in the same class number more than once (even with a different rider) per [ED 102.2](#)
3. **Horses may not compete in more than 4 classes per day.**
4. Horses may only compete in levels that are adjacent with the same rider. For example, a horse may not be ridden in a basic level test and a level two test UNLESS with a different rider. [WD 102](#).
5. A horse may be ridden by a maximum of two riders. [WD 102](#).
6. To be eligible for Intro Level, a horse/rider combination must not have shown in a WD test at First level or above in the same competition year. [WD 103.1](#).
7. **H4H/SSWD** reserves the right to limit Open exhibitors to showing only 2 of the 3 days, in the event the show is completely sold out to accommodate additional amateur, junior, and new riders. As you know our shows have moved to a 3-day format in the attempt to accommodate new riders and we continue to sell out this is a way to ensure all can compete and we thank our Open riders for their understanding.

Horses not competing: Non-showing horses are allowed on the grounds if space is available. The owner/trainer must enter the horse on an entry form, pay office, stall, and a non-competing horse fee, and meet all health requirements.

Dogs: Well-mannered and quiet dogs are allowed, they must be on leash at all times, owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Proof of current rabies must be available on request.

Motorized vehicles: Cars/Trucks will be parked in designated parking areas while not loading or unloading. Golf carts, scooters, ATVs, are only allowed if approved by AEC management and will only be operated by an adult 16 years of age or older with a valid driver's license.

Hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accident Policy: Show management reserves the right to adjust times or cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, or emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.

ENTRIES, SCHEDULING, AND SCORING

A. General Information

1. Registrations fees will not be accepted in advance of Registration Deadline for each show. The show secretary will email billing invoice with payment options after the registration deadline has closed. All fees must be paid, all waivers signed, and horse health information received before an exhibitor is allowed to show.
2. Entries are accepted on a first come first serve basis. Entries may be limited (see #7 under class restrictions).
3. Late entries are accepted (those not on the original wait list after closing) on a space-available basis and a class late fee of \$20/class late.
4. Upon Show Registration Close Date: Any change (horse, rider or class change) must be communicated directly to the Office Show Secretary and will incur the listed charge fees documented in the Registration Fee/Charges/Refund Chart on page 2. Class and Administrative fees are nonrefundable.
5. If classes are oversubscribed, a “wait list” will be maintained. Horses will be added to the show based on the wait list order prior to scheduling. After the show has been timed, the show secretary will work wait list horses in the show based on the best fit with the schedule. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

B. Scheduling

1. Ride Conflicts: Competitors with multiple horses and horses with multiple riders are urged to bring enough help. If a conflict is discovered, notify the show secretary immediately.
2. Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, combine or cancel classes, and modify the schedule to make whatever changes are required by circumstances to the competition specifications listed herein. Management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of an entry for cause deemed enough by Show Management.

C. Official Ride Times

1. Provisional ride times: Provisional ride times will be available on Hope 4 Hooves/Silver State Western Dressage Facebook page, h4hsswd.com, and will be emailed 1-2 weeks before the show date.

D. Scores

1. It is the responsibility of the competitor to verify the accuracy of all scores. Scoring errors must be reported to the Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last class of the show day during which the score was earned.

All Event related participants, guests, volunteers, and show staff must conduct themselves professionally, and respectful toward each other and toward the Judges, AEC management team and Clark County staff. Please contact Show Management with your concerns and questions.
- B. H4H/SSWD reserves the right to remove individuals from the premises for disorderly conduct or failure to comply with the above terms.
- C. H4H/SSWD reserves the right to give written notice for any disorderly conduct or conduct infraction, and we reserve the right to refuse future event registrations in the event of afore mentioned infractions.
- D. Please read and will follow the Western Dressage Association Code of Conduct at [Western Dressage Code of Conduct](#) .
- E. H4H/Show Waiver - SSWD & H4H ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION - Please fill out and submit one form for every Horse/Rider Combination. This Form may be updated between shows, it is important to fill out for each show you attend. Thank you. [H4H/SSWD Show Waiver](#)

SCHOOLING – Managed and Supervised by Staff Warm-up Steward. Please follow the direction of our Warm-up Arena Steward and review warm-up arena etiquette compliance acknowledged by your signed show waivers. All horses must have their Show Number attached to saddle pad or handler shirt back.

1. Schooling is allowed in the Dressage Court Arena beginning Thursday afternoon/evening.
2. During the show exhibitors are allowed into the warmup arena 45 minutes before their ride time.
3. Please note ride times are not “written in stone” classes may run early or late, exhibitors are responsible for awareness of ride times, scheduled breaks etc.
4. Friday-Saturday horses may work in the show arena after the show is completed.
5. No schooling in the show arena is allowed during the scheduled show times/breaks
6. **All horses on show grounds during show days must be registered at the show office and issued an H4H SSWD BRIDLE & SADDLE Show Number.**
 - When on show grounds, please ensure your horse’s assigned Show Number is on your halter or your saddle pad or on the back of your shirt. When showing the horse may wear show number on bridle or saddle number or both.
 - Non-Competing Horses may be allowed in the warmup arena and are under the same supervision and direction of show management. Non-Competing Horse Registration fee is \$40.
 - Please ensure your Show Number is on your halter or your saddle pad or on the back of your shirt. When showing the horse may wear show number on bridle or saddle number or both.

LUNGING – Managed and Supervised by Staff Warm-up Steward. Please follow the direction of our Warm-up Arena Steward and review warm-up arena etiquette compliance acknowledged by your signed show waivers. All horses must have their show number on the bridle or the saddle blanket.

1. Lunging is not allowed in the show arena at any time
2. Lunging area is designated in the cow pen located at the east side of the competition for 30 minutes per horse.

In Gate and Tack & Attire Check Managed and Supervised by Staff Ring Steward

1. Only horse/rider on deck and exiting horse allowed at the In-Gate Entrance Area
2. To be compliant with our memorandum of understanding with WDAA we will randomly select one third of the horses in each class/test immediately as the horse leaves the arena. Please review at [WDAA Equipment Check Process for Western Dressage](#) .
